In the late nineteenth century, second-rate actors couldn't afford cold cream to remove their stage makeup, so they used ham fat and were called hamfatters until early in the twentieth century when these bad actors were simply called "hams." Physical comedy became known as "slapstick" because of its regular use of crude sound effects: two sticks were slapped together off-stage to accentuate a comic's onstage pratfall (prat being an Old English term for buttocks).

At our November General Meeting, Rick Durham introduced Novelist **Barbara Dickson**, Author of 'Bomb Girls: Trading Aprons for Ammo'



Most Canadians are unaware that an extensive, long-abandoned tunnel system runs under the streets of the eastern GTA, Ontario. Over 80 years ago, the Canadian government built a *top secret* munitions factory in the rural community of Scarborough, just seven miles from Toronto's downtown. The plant, called GECO—General Engineering Company (Canada) Limited— comprised 346 acres, 172 buildings, and over four kilometers of underground passageways. Barbara's presentation was a comprehensive, historical record of Canada's biggest WWII munitions plant, GECO, which employed over 21,000 citizens, predominantly women, courageously working with high explosives around the clock. Barbara delivered a dramatic, personal, and detailed review of GECO and shared with us the incredible contribution made by so many women, so long ago. What was it really like to work in a munitions factory? Did anyone die? What were working conditions like? How closely did bomb girls resemble "Rosie the Riveter?"

Barbara draws from over 20 years of research to answer these questions.
